### “Universal Design for Learning”

Workshop Description: As a result of IDEA and ESEA/NCLB, many students who used to be excluded from the general education curriculum are expected to progress in the general education classroom and curriculum. Teachers now need to be successful with a much more diverse group of students but the print-based curriculum they use is not flexible or adjustable for different learner needs. Universal Design for Learning (UDL) principles help educators address these challenges by offering increased opportunity for all students to access, participate, and progress in the general education curriculum. In this training session we present principles of UDL and show examples of how to apply them in classroom practice.
